Generosity

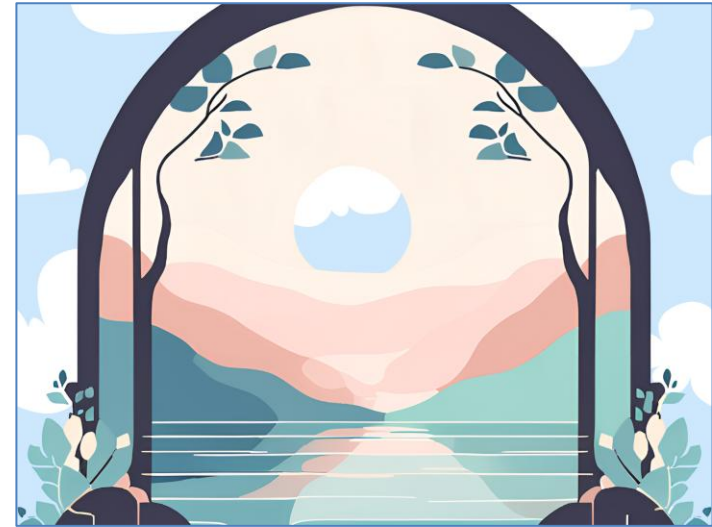
We cultivate a spirit of gratitude and hope.
